

See your design through the tools

Is 21" screen still too small to fit all the useful panels and see the layout at the same time? Are you considering buying second screen and using it just to store the panels?

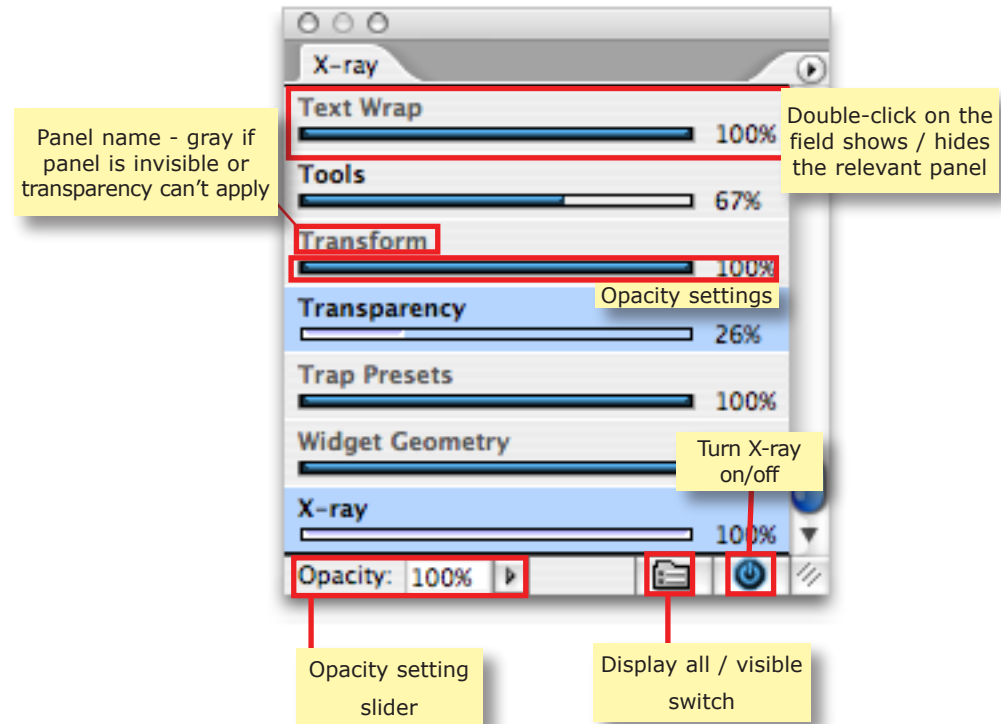
Before you spend money on a new screen, try X-ray. This plug-in allows you to set opacity to every panel in InDesign. From now on, you will be able to set opacity to all the tools, which are so essential for your work, but obstruct the view on the actual design. Some of the panels can have 20% transparency and still be useful, while not hiding the more important thing - your work.

Key features

X-ray plug-in works as a list of all InDesign panels and tool bars. You can set desired opacity to each of these

The list can display either all panels, or only the visible ones. You can turn opacity on or off with a single click or hot key.

In Mac version, you can set opacity to all panels and control palette. Windows version currently doesn't support opacity for panels in stash and for control palette if docked.
